Part 5: The Holy Spirit's Active Involvement

THE HOLY SPIRIT HELPS THE EARLY CHURCH

- A. He was instrumental in reaching out to the Gentiles (Acts 10:19-20 NKJV)
 - 1. The Jewish believers did not consider Gentiles within the sphere of salvation
 - 2. It required a vision and direct command from the Holy Spirit to open that door
- B. He helped guide the early church into a major decision regarding the nations (Acts 15:28 NKJV)
 - 1. The early church used the scriptures and the direct involvement of the Holy Spirit
 - a. A classic example of how God's guidance worked for early believers in making decisions
- C. He helped steer Paul into God's plan for his life and ministry (Acts 16:6-8 NKJV)
 - 1. Paul had developed a sensitivity to the Holy Spirit and His leadings
 - 2. Paul also had a willingness in him to yield

THE HOLY SPIRIT'S INVOLVEMENT IN OUR LIVES TODAY

- A. He helps us by offering guidance (John 16:13 NKJV)
 - 1. He will always guide us in agreement with God's word
 - a. He is the Spirit of Truth who inspired the scriptures
 - 2. He does not force or push
 - a. Guidance has to be responded to
 - b. This agrees with the picture of the Lord as our Shepherd
- B. He helps us by telling us about the future
 - 1. Insight into the future is a huge help
 - a. The value of being prepared
 - 2. The Holy Spirit warned Paul regarding what was coming his way (Acts 20:22-23 NKJV)
 - a. Paul was not caught off guard
 - 3. Paul was warned about an upcoming storm (Acts 27:9-10 NKJV)
 - a. He did not directly reference the Holy Spirit
 - b. Paul talked about an inward perception or knowing (Romans 8:16 NKJV)
- C. He helps us by teaching us (John 14:26 NKJV)
 - 1. He reveals to us the mind of Christ and the will of God (1 Corinthians 2:9-13 NKJV)
 - a. Reveal = to unveil or uncover
 - b. He reveals God's word and God's plan for our lives
