## **CONFIDENCE BOOSTERS**

- The belief connection
  - 1. What we believe, right or wrong, has impact
  - 2. Believing we have the capacity
  - 3. Relational confidence is a belief that we are on good ground
- · Confidence with God is based on beliefs
  - 1. What we believe about Him His nature and character
  - 2. What we believe about ourselves because of what He has done in us
  - 3. What we believe about our relationship with Him (Luke 1:45 NLT)

## SAMSON'S CONFIDENCE AND DOWNFALL

- Samson believed the source of his strength (Judges 15:12-15 NKJV)
  - 1. He was not afraid of being arrested and bound
  - 2. He was not afraid to face his enemies
  - 3. The Spirit of the Lord empowered him
- Samson believed he was special (Judges 16:15-17 and 19-20 NKJV)
  - 1. He knew he was the product of a supernatural birth
  - 2. He knew he was a Nazirite from the womb
  - 3. He also knew that without that connection, he would be weakened
- · Samson did not place enough value in this special connection to God
  - 1. The enemy pestered and pressed him
  - 2. He was not aware of the enemy or the consequences

## THE BOOSTERS AND BUSTERS THAT IMPACT OUR CONFIDENCE (WHAT WE BELIEVE HAS IMPACT)

- Believe in our spiritual power source (2 Timothy 1:7 NKJV)
  - 1. We have the same Spirit of the Lord that was on Samson
  - 2. Because we don't see, feel, or mentally grasp does not mean there is nothing there
  - 3. Acknowledge His help and power
- · Believe what God has done for us in Christ
  - 1. Samson knew he was special from birth
  - 2. We can know that we are special (1 Peter 2:9 NKJV)
- Place great value on our relationship and connection to the Lord
  - 1. Recognize the attempts of the enemy to steal our strength
  - 2. We must keep our heart clear with the Lord (1 John 3:20-21 NKJV)
  - 3. The stronger our connection, the stronger our confidence
