THE LORD'S PRAYER AS A PATTERN (Matthew 6:9-13 NKJV)

- Recap
 - 1. Hallowed be Your name
 - a. Starting with praise and acknowledgement of God
 - 2. Your Kingdom come Your will be done
 - a. Praying about the things that concern God's Kingdom
 - b. Praying about things that pertain to God's will (Ezekiel 34:3-6 NKJV)
 - 3. Give us this day our daily bread
 - a. It's right to ask God for the things you need
 - b. Also to ask for the spiritual things we need for the day

FORGIVE US AND DELIVER US

- Forgive us
 - 1. There is initial forgiveness when we receive Jesus as Savior (Acts 26:18 NKJV)
 - 2. Forgiveness when we miss it after we are new creations in Him (1 John 1:9 NKJV)
- · As we forgive
 - 1. Unforgiveness clogs up our prayers (Mark 11:25 NKJV)
 - 2. Forgiveness is connected to being tender hearted (Ephesians 4:32 NKJV)
 - 3. Forgiveness for an occasion of complaint (Colossians 3:13 NKJV)
 - 4. We can ask the Lord for His help in the forgiveness area
- Lead us out of temptation and deliver us from evil
 - 1. The Lord is not leading us into places where we will fall (James 1:12-14 NKJV)
 - 2. The Lord knows how to get us out of evil and temptation (2 Peter 2:7-9 NKJV)
