A KINGDOM PERSPECTIVE ON HOW TO HANDLE A LOSS

- Don't narrowly assign the blame
 1. Take the condition of our nation into account
 2. Recognize the times we are living in **(2 Timothy 3:1&13 NKJV)**
- Understand people's emotions are in a rawer state, especially this year
 1. This election is not the only challenge we are facing
 2. Hurting people hurt people
 3. Aim to follow Jesus' example **(1 Peter 2:23 NLT)**
- Don't lash out in a loss or gloat in a win
 1. No sense in blowing up relationships
 2. We can act differently because we are different **(Titus 3:1-3 NLT)**
- We live with a bigger purpose in mind
 1. A win is not proving you're right - it's shining your light **(Matthew 5:14 & 16 NKJ)**
 2. A bigger purpose helps us move past the present problems **(Matthew 15:23-28 NKJV)**
 3. Regardless of the outcome, our mission has not changed - for the saving of households
- God is still God and His kingdom blessings and benefits are still in play
 1. We still have access to His peace
 2. We still have His help
 3. The Greater One the Holy Spirit still lives in us
 4. We still overcome because He still loves us **(Romans 8:37 NKJV)**
