THE PURSUIT OF PEACE

- What does peace mean to you?
 - 1. No hostilities / fighting
 - 2. No stress / turmoil
 - 3. No anxiety / frustration calmness in our inner life
- What does God want for you? (2 Thessalonians 3:16 NKJ)
 - 1. He is the Lord of peace
 - 2. He wants peace for His children

A Man Who Found Peace

- · There was no peace in the land
 - 1. Israel had abandoned God
 - 2. God sent them a prophet to tell them why there was no peace
- Gideon believed the wrong things (Judges 6:11-16 NKJ)
 - 1. He believed his bad situation was God's fault
 - 2. He believed too much in his own personal weaknesses
- Gideon makes an adjustment (Judges 6:21-24 NKJ)
 - 1. Believed that God was against him
 - 2. Had a revelation of who God really is
 - 3. Built an altar a permanent reminder of the Lord is peace

THE GOD OF PEACE IN YOUR LIFE

- Peace with God (Romans 5:1 NKJ)
 - 1. The starting place
 - 2. No longer a separation between us and God
- Believe the right way
 - 1. God is our answer not our problem (Psalms 46:1 NKJ)
 - 2. God's work in us is stronger than our weaknesses (Ephesians 2:10 NKJ)
- Put God's peace into practice (Philippians 4:6-7 NKJ)
 - 1. This promise belongs to you in Christ
