WHEN YOU PRAY Part 4

THE LORD'S PRAYER (Matthew 6:9-13 NKJV)

- A pattern for prayer
 - 1. Can also be prayed as is
- Forgive us our debts as we forgive
 - 1. We have forgiveness initially when we receive Christ
 - We have forgiveness available when we sin as believers
 - 3. We also must forgive others

LEAD US OUT OF TEMPTATION / DELIVER US FROM EVIL

- Temptation: Tests, trials, a solicitation to sin
 - 1. The Lord is not leading us into situations to sin (James 1:13-14 NKJV) (Matthew 4:3 NKJV)
 - 2. Jesus spoke about temptation (Matthew 26:41 NKJV)
- We have help available in regards to temptation (Hebrew 4:14-16 NKJV)
 - 1. We have Jesus representing us as our High Priest
 - 2. Jesus was tempted to sin but He did not
 - 3. But we can come boldly to the throne of grace
- The Lord knows how to deliver us (2 Peter 2:7-9 NKJV)
 - 1. Lot got himself into this environment
 - 2. What he was continually around tormented his righteous soul
 - God got him and his family out
- Deliver us from evil (2 Timothy 4:17-18 NKJV)
 - 1. Out of the mouth of the lion is pretty close
 - 2. Paul experienced real problems preaching the gospel
 - 3. When we pray we must be clear that God is not the source of the evil (1 Peter 5:8-9 NKJV)
