SOWING AND REAPING IS A UNIVERSAL LIFE PRINCIPLE

- Different kinds of seeds
 - 1. Words
 - 2. Actions
 - Material goods
- A God-ordained law in the earth (Galatians 6:7-10 NKJ)
 - 1. God is not mocked good seeds and bad seeds, both produce
 - 2. We are encouraged to not give up doing good
 - 3. Doing good is planting seeds

WHEN SMALL SEEDS MET SOME BIG NEEDS (Matthew15:32-38 NKJ)

- Jesus had compassion on hungry people
 - 1. Three days of church and the food ran out
 - 2. Jesus did not want them hungry and too weak for the journey home
- What do you have?
 - 3. Seven loaves and a few fish way too small to feed 6-8k people
 - 4. Had to leave the disciples hand
- In Jesus' hands it became a miracle seed
 - 1. Jesus did not materialize the food out of thin air, He used the seed
 - 2. Small seeds produced big results

PLANTING SEEDS TODAY

- Jesus is moved with compassion and so are we
 - 1. We are His church His body in the earth (1 Corinthians 12:27 NKJ)
 - 2. As a church collectively we'll continue to reach out and plant seeds
 - 3. Individually you represent Him and can reach out
- Seeds will leave your hand but they don't leave your life
 - 1. The decision to hold it or sow it is always a factor a step of faith
 - 2. But God's ways are not mocked we will reap a harvest
- God can do amazing things when we plant seeds (2 Corinthians 9:8 NKJ)
 - 1. Grace abounding comes after seeds are planted
 - 2. Important to follow/obey Him in this area
- Jesus was the greatest seed ever sown
 - 1. He referred to Himself as a seed
 - 2. He had to die (be planted)
 - 3. But God raised Him up and look at the harvest!!
