EARS TO HEAR (Mark 4:9-11 NKJ)

A. Jesus was speaking to regular people

1. He must have been referring to something other than regular ears

B. Jesus was willing to explain this parable

- 1. Insight was not limited to the 12 only
- Insight was given to the people who stayed and asked
- 3. The ones with desire were the ones to whom it was given
- 4. This gives us insight into how God's kingdom operates

THE PARABLE EXPLAINED: GOD'S SEED OUR HEART (Mark 4:13-20 NKJ)

A. God's word is spiritual seed

- 1. Matthew calls it the word of the Kingdom
- 2. By referencing seed Jesus is giving us and indication of how God's word works
- 3. God's word is perfect seed it will produce under the right conditions

B. The hard heart

- 1. Referred to as wayside a road a street
- 2. This is an unreceptive heart
- 3. People who will not receive for various reasons
- 4. This is not a fixed condition hearts can change

C. The high enthusiasm low heat tolerance heart

- 1. Jesus referred to this as a rocky ground with no depth lacked moisture
- Received Gods' word with joy so they believed
- 3. The challenge here is an unwillingness to endure when the heat came
- 4. If you start enthusiastic, you can stay enthusiastic
