## **CONFIDENCE: A TRUST IN SOMEONE OR SOMETHING**

- · Places we place confidence
  - 1. Ourselves
  - 2. Other people and institutions
  - 3. God
- Confidence can be discarded (Hebrews 10:35 NKJ)
  - 1. Implies you have the choice
  - 2. The best long term strategy is to hold onto to your confidence

## WHEN THE DISCIPLES DID NOT UNDERSTAND (John 6:57-63, 66-69 NKJ)

- Jesus said some things they did not understand
  - 1. They took His words at face value
  - 2. Many of His disciples went to the back and stopped walking with Him
- Jesus did not respond to the exodus
  - 1. He directed no anger nor did He criticize the ones who walked away
  - He did not apologize for His words or try to restate them
  - 3. He asked the twelve about their choice always a choice with God
- Peter's response to Jesus
  - 1. Who are we going to go to?
  - 2. He professed his faith in who Jesus was

## KEEPING YOUR CONFIDENCE WHEN YOU DON'T UNDERSTAND

- There is more to life than meets the eye (2 Corinthians 4:16-18 NKJ)
  - 1. There is a spiritual realm beyond the realm we feel and see
  - 2. We are not going to understand everything
- Recognize there is no better plan
  - 1. Where are you going to go?
  - 2. Other religions can't offer the love, the forgiveness and the hope that is Christ
  - 3. Science and technology limited and offers nothing past this life
  - 4. Back to a life with no restrictions/ boundaries only good for a season
- · Give voice to your beliefs
  - 1. Not your doubts, complaints and questions
  - 2. Engage that heart/mouth connection (Romans 10:10 NKJ)
