## THE HOLY SPIRIT AFTER SALVATION

- The first outpouring (Acts 2:1-4 NKJ)
  - 1. To the 120 in the upper room on the day of Pentecost
  - 2. They were filled and began to speak as He gave utterance
  - 3. The Holy Spirit does not do the speaking or speak through us
- The Holy Spirit and the Samaritans (Acts 8:12,14-19 NKJ)
  - 1. The Samaritans had received the word of God and were baptized
  - 2. He had fallen upon none another experience
  - 3. No reference to speaking with tongues but something was visible
- The Holy Spirit and the Gentiles (Acts 10:44-47 NKJ)
  - 1. The gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out
  - 2. They recognized the gift because they heard them speak with tongues
- The Holy Spirit at Ephesus (Acts 19:1-6 NKJ)
  - 1. Why ask the question
  - 2. This group had not been saved they were actually disciples of John the Baptist
  - 3. Paul told them about Jesus he did not lay hands on them
  - 4. After baptism Paul laid hands on them and the Holy Spirit came upon them

## WHAT ABOUT TODAY?

- The outpouring of the Holy Spirit passed away
  - 1. Only one verse makes a reference to tongues stopping (1 Corinthians 13:8 NKJ)
- The gift of the Holy Spirit stopped when the last apostle died (Ephesians 4:11-13 NKJ)
  - 1. What about the other 4 gifts?
  - 2. These are ministry gifts to help the Church
