- They heard a message (1 Thessalonians 2:1-4, 8-9 NKJV)
 - 1. Three times, Paul mentions preaching to them the gospel of God
- They received the message (1 Thessalonians 2:13 NKJV)
 - 1. But not as man's word, as the word of God (Romans 1:16-17 NKJV)
- God's words are seeds of faith (Mark 4:14-17 NKJV)
 - 1. The first group never received God's word (Luke 8:18 ESV)
 - 2. The second group received God's words with joy (Philippians 4:4 NKJV)
- Faith in God is faith in His word (Romans 10:17 NKJV)
 - 1. We can have faith in different areas of life
 - Faith to live free from fear (John 14:27 NKJV)
 - Faith for healing (1 Peter 2:24 NKJV)
 - Faith for help (Hebrews 13:5-6 NKJV)
 - Faith to stand against the attacks of the enemy (1 Peter 5:8-9 NKJV)
