 - 2. Pain physical, mental, and/or emotional discomfort or suffering
 - 3. Problems a situation, matter, or person that causes difficulty or needs to be dealt with

HIS STORY

- · Jesus was under pressure
 - 1. Expectations from the people that He would restore Israel to power
 - 2. The internal pressure before the cross (Luke 22:44 NKJV)
- Jesus experienced pain (John 19:1-5 NKJV)
 - 1. Pilate wanted to let Jesus go he knew Jesus was innocent
 - 2. Jesus passed up the gall a drink that would numb the pain
- Jesus dealt with problems
 - 1. Family problems His siblings did not believe in Him
 - 2. His team; one betrayed Him, one denied knowing Him, all of them abandoned Him
 - 3. For three years, He was consistently opposed by the religious elite of the nation *(Luke 23:34 NKJV)*
 - 4. The biggest problem Jesus dealt with and resolved was not His it was our problem. (Romans 3:23 NKJV) (Romans 4:24-25 NKJV)
