WHO ARE YOU?

- What do you identify with?
 - 1. Accomplishments / failures
 - 2. Past history / personal demographics
 - 3. Things that change
- A stronger identity (Psalm 112:6-8 NIV)
 - 1. The things listed above can't establish your heart
 - 2. Your heart can be secure in what God says about you

LOW LEVEL LIVING DESPITE A HIGH LEVEL CONNECTION (2 Samuel 9:3-10 NIV)

- A prince who's life took a tragic turn
 - 1. The grandson of a king forced to run for his life
- · He unknowingly had a contract with a king
 - 1. Had no knowledge of the power of his connection to David
 - 2. Thought David was his enemy the source of his low level living
 - 3. Mephibosheth identified far beneath his actual status
- David elevated him and restored his inheritance
 - 1. Treated as one of the king's sons
 - 2. Gave him a helper to do what he could not do on his own
 - 3. Mephibosheth went from weakness to a place of strength

ELEVATING YOUR IDENTITY AND ESTABLISHING YOUR HEART

- Identify with God who is for you (Psalm 118:6-7 NKJV)
 - 1. He is not the reason for the negatives in your life
 - 2. Being afraid of Him will not establish your heart with strength
- Identify with Christ and what He has done for you (1 Peter 2:9-10 NIV)
 - 1. Through faith in Christ you have become royalty
 - 2. You look good in Christ
- Identify with the reality that you have help (John 14:26 NKJV)
 - 1. Mephibosheth had a lot of help and so do you
 - 2. God's help is greater than your weakness
