LESSONS FROM A FAMOUS FATHER

FATHERHOOD

- A. Not an easy job
 - 1. Whether done right or wrong it's impactful
 - 2. Not a lot of direct biblical instructions to fathers (Ephesians 6:4 NKJ)

FATHER ABRAHAM (Genesis 22:1-12 NKJ)

- A. Abraham's love for Issac was evident
 - 1. Issac was a miracle child
 - 2. God referenced Abraham's love for Issac
- B. There was good communication between Abraham and Issac
 - 1. Issac knew he could ask a question
 - 2. Abraham's answer was revealing Here I am
- C. A high level of trust had been established
 - 1. Issac was old enough to carry the wood
 - 2. He allowed himself to be bound and put on the altar
- D. Abraham honored God over his son
 - 1. If Issac had been first in Abraham's life he would not have made the trip
 - Abraham's love and devotion to God was tangible

RELATIONAL LESSONS FROM ABRAHAM

- A. Love is the best thing we can give (*Proverbs 15:17 NKJ*)
 - 1. As men, we are wired to want to provide
 - 2. The environment we provide is what creates lasting value
- B. Good communication is important (1 Thessalonians 2:11-12 NIV)
 - 1. Encourage everyone needs encouragement
 - 2. Comfort is important, especially in the difficult seasons
 - 3. Urging to live right and do right not forcing
- C. Trust is vital to any good relationship
 - 1. Trust is earned and built especially as children get older
- D. Put God first in your life (Joshua 24:15 NKJ)
 - 1. We live in a land where many do not serve God
 - 2. We have to choose choose for the long run
