THE HOLY SPIRIT IN THE LIFE OF JESUS

A. Pre and post birth

- 1. The Holy Spirit at conception
- 2. The Holy Spirit encouraged Mary during her pregnancy (Luke 1:39-43 NKJV)
- 3. The Holy Spirit confirmed Jesus at His dedication (Luke 2:25-30 NKJV)

B. The early ministry of Jesus

- 1. John the Baptist spoke of Jesus and the Holy Spirit (Luke 3:16 NKJV)
- 2. We see the Holy Spirit on Jesus at the start of His ministry (Luke 3:21-22 NKJV)
- 3. Jesus referenced the Holy Spirit's equipping Him to help people (Luke 4:18 NKJV) (Acts 10:38 NKJV)

THE HOLY SPIRIT HELPS THE EARLY CHURCH

A. He was instrumental in reaching out to the Gentiles (Acts 10:19-20 NKJV)

- 1. The Jewish believers did not consider Gentiles within the sphere of salvation
- 2. It required a vision and direct command from the Holy Spirit to open that door

B. He helped guide the early church into a major decision regarding the nations (Acts 15:28 NKJV)

1. The early church used the scriptures and the direct involvement of the Holy Spirit

C. He helped steer Paul into God's plan for his life and ministry (Acts 16:6-8 NKJV)

- 1. Paul had developed a sensitivity to the Holy Spirit and His leadings
- 2. Paul also had a willingness in him to yield

D. The Holy Spirit has not lost any of His capacity to help us

- 1. He still has insight into things we are blind to
- 2. He can still help us make decisions
- 3. He can still lead us into God's best for our lives we have to also be willing
