NOT AN EASY JOB

- A much maligned role (warranted and unwarranted)
 - 1. The ratio of single moms to dads is high
 - 2. Fatherhood the most attacked and least celebrated
 - 3. A challenging role to navigate clarity is seemingly harder to come by
- Fatherhood is a God-ordained role
 - 1. Styles may vary but the heart of fatherhood is what is most important (Luke 1:17 NKJ)

JESUS REVEALED THE FATHER'S HEART (Luke 15:11-24 NKJ)

- · A heart to give
 - 1. This whole parable was the antithesis of Jewish thought
 - 2. The younger son asked for his inheritance before the father died
 - 3. The father divided his goods and the son cashed out and left
- · The freedom to chose
 - 1. The father did not force the son to stay
 - 2. He did not go after the son and stop him from wasting the money
 - 3. He did not beg the son to come home
- A heart of compassion
 - 1. The father kept looking for the son to return
 - 2. After the son moved toward home the father moved towards the son
 - 3. Allowed the child to repent but restored him to his place as a son
- · An understanding of the big picture
 - 1. The son's life and past were not celebrated
 - 2. The restoration of relationship was the most important thing

A FATHER'S HEART; A NEVER ENDING PROCESS

- A heart to provide
 - 1. This is a God-ordained desire
 - 2. More than money protection, security, direction and encouragement (1 Thess. 2:11 NKJ)
- A willingness to establish parameters
 - 1. Setting boundaries and order
 - 2. When done in a godly way it can bring peace to a home
- A heart of compassion
 - 1. Never stop looking for your children
 - 2. Willingness to forgive and restore
 - 3. Willingness to express love and acceptance
- Celebrating what's right
 - 1. The relationship is the most valued thing loving them without celebrating their lifestyle
 - 2. The biggest celebration is for when the relationship with God is there (Luke 15:7 NKJ)
