- It's not all easy and downhill
 - 1. Surprises
 - 2. Setbacks
 - 3. Pain physical and people pain
- Believers do not navigate life alone (Hebrews 4:14-15 NKJV)
 - 1. We have someone who walks with us
 - 2. So we hold on to what we believe

JESUS DEALT WITH MORE THAN PHYSICAL PAIN

- The pain of betrayal (John 13:10-12a NKJV)
 - 1. Betrayal to be false or disloyal to, to deliver into the hands of the enemy
 - 2. Jesus still washed Judas' feet and never exposed him
- The pain of abandonment (Luke 22:60-61 NKJV)
 - 1. Peter was part of Jesus' inner circle
 - 2. Peter separated himself from Jesus
- The pain of abuse from strangers (Matthew 27:27-31 NKJV)
 - 1. After being physically beaten badly
 - 2. Roman soldiers mocked and spit on Him
- The pain of rejection from those who He had been good to (Matthew 27:22-23 NKJV)
 - 1. Rejected by people He had helped, healed and blessed
 - 2. People who Jesus never hurt wanted Him crucified

NAVIGATING YOUR WAY THROUGH PEOPLE PAIN

- Go to the One who understands
 - 1. He has experienced pain and will not condemn you
 - 2. He invites you to come get help (Hebrews 4:16 NKJV)
- Commit don't quit
 - 1. Don't allow people pain to push you off course (1 Peter 2:23 NKJV)
 - 2. Commit your ways to Him
 - 3. Don't strike back at people it will not make the pain go away
- Stay connected to the One who is bigger than the pain
 - 1. Pain clouds perspective
 - 2. There is hope beyond the pain (Romans 15:13 NKJV)
