DIFFERENT CAN MEAN DIFFERENT

- Different denotes...
 - 1. Being odd, weird, or awkward
 - 2. Being unique march to the beat of a different drum
 - 3. Can be good or bad
- · As a believer in Christ, we are different
 - 1. Primarily different inside
 - 2. We must know what are the difference we now have in Christ (Romans 12:2 NKJ)
 - 3. We allow what's different on the inside to show up on the outside

TWO DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES

- God promised a land (Numbers 13:1-2 NKJ)
 - 1. This was initiated by God
 - 2. Two reports were generated (Numbers 13:30-31 NKJ)
- The people went with the majority report (Numbers 14:3-4,6-10 NKJ)
 - 1. The people cried all night and wanted to return to Egypt
 - 2. Joshua and Caleb were different
- God highlighted the difference between the two perspectives (Numbers 14:22-24 NKJ)
 - 1. The 10 spies did not value all the Lord had done for them
 - 2. The people who followed the 10 spies rejected the Lord
 - 3. But Caleb and Joshua had a different spirit

LIVING WITH A DIFFERENT SPIRIT

- We are people of promise (2 Peter 1:4 NLT)
 - 1. God's promises are for us
 - 2. God's promises enable us to live differently
- We are people with possibilities (Mark 9:23 NKJ)
 - 1. Because we believe in the promises He has given us
 - 2. We live by faith not by sight
- We are people God is pleased with (Romans 8:31-32 NKJ)
 - 1. So we believe God will help us
 - 2. Because we believe we are helped, we don't live in fear
