TAKE UP AND PUT ON

- A. Not physical armor so not physical action
 - 1. Involves awareness
 - 2. Involves intentional application (Ephesians 4:21-24 NKJV)
 - 3. Involves faith on our part (2 Corinthians 4:13 NKJV)
- B. Armor tells us what we stand against (Ephesians 6:14-15 NKJV)
 - 1. This is insight into what the strategies of the enemy are in our lives
 - 2. Belt of truth (1 Timothy 4:1 NKJV)
 - 3. Breastplate of righteousness (Romans 5:7 NKJV)
 - 4. Shoes of peace (John 14:27 NKJV)

SHOES OF PEACE (Ephesians 6:15 NKJV)

- A. A firm foundation
 - 1. "... shoes of the good news of peace, a firm foundation for your feet."
 - The good news of peace corresponds with the Hebrew word shalom (Romans 5:1 NKJV)
- B. Peace is more than a feeling (Luke 1:79 NKJV) (2 Thessalonians 3:16 NKJV)
