WHAT DIFFERENCE DOES CHRISTIANITY MAKE? Part 3 (Hope)

WE GOTTA HAVE HOPE

- · Living with hope a confident favorable expectation
 - 1. Hope with our teams
 - 2. Hope in our relationships
 - 3. Hope for the future
- God's plan for His people is that they would have hope (Romans 15:13 NKJV)
 - 1. He is the God of hope
 - 2. He wants us full of hope
 - 3. What we believe plays a part in our hope

HOPE IN THE STORM

- A voice before the storm (Acts 27:9-12 NKJV)
 - 1. Paul perceived big trouble ahead
 - 2. He had no voice/influence at this juncture of the trip
- Hope was lost and found (Acts 27:20-25 NKJV)
 - 1. The storm was not letting up
 - 2. God injects hope into the middle of the storm
- · The difference in Paul
 - 1. He identified with the living God
 - 2. He believed what God said would happen
 - 3. Paul had hope for himself and everyone on the boat

THE DIFFERENCE IS WE ARE A PEOPLE WITH HOPE

- Pay attention to the whispers of your heart
 - 1. The One who knows the future lives in us (John 16:13 NKJV)
- · Identify strongly with your connection to God
 - 1. Our connection with God is through Jesus (Ephesians 2:19 NKJV)
 - 2. We strengthen that connection by our relationship with Him
- · Believe beyond what is
 - 1. Believing beyond what is right in front of us
 - 2. Believing God's promises to us creates an expectation of what will be
 - 3. As we do, we'll have more than enough hope for our lives
