SECURITY MEASURES Part 8: The Directive to Be Strong

Text: Ephesians 6:10-11 NKJV

THE DIRECTIVE TO BE STRONG

- A. Written to a church under pressure
 - 1. The early church was often persecuted
 - 2. Makes sense that when you are under pressure you listen differently
- B. The directive to be strong was not limited to this one particular church
 - 1. Paul wrote the church at Corinth (1 Corinthians 16:13-14 NKJV)
 - 2. Paul encouraged Timothy to be strong (2 Timothy 2:1 NKJV)
 - 3. Paul prayed for the believers to be strengthened (*Ephesians 3:16 NKJV*) (*Colossians 1:9-11 NKJV*)
 - 4. Has to be the will and plan of God for us to be strong

STRONG IN THE LORD

- A. In the Lord is a spiritual position
 - 1. Refers to what Jesus has done for us
 - 2. The terms "in Christ" and "in Him" (1 Corinthians 6:17 NKJV)
- B. In the Lord is a place of great blessing and provision
 - 1. Blessed, chosen, adopted, accepted
 - 2. Redeemed (purchased), forgiven, given an inheritance
 - 3. Sealed with the Holy Spirit
- C. To be strong in the Lord...
 - 1. Have a knowledge of what has been done for us in Christ
 - 2. Believe what has been done for us in Christ (Hebrews 11:33-34 NKJV)
 - 3. Act on what has been done for us in Christ (2 Corinthians 4:13 NKJV)
