- Who do you say?
 - 1. Asking His disciples how they saw Him
 - 2. Peter had the right answer (Matthew 16:16-17 NKJV)

THE SAME SCENARIO WITH TWO DIFFERENT VISIONS

• What the ten spies saw (Numbers 13:31-33 NKJV)

- 1. We can not do this the people are stronger than we are
- 2. The land is beautiful, but a hard place to live
- 3. We look like grasshoppers to us

• What Caleb and Joshua saw (Numbers 13:30 NKJV) (Numbers 14:6-9 NKJV)

- 1. We can do this let's go now
- 2. This is a really good land
- 3. There is no reason to be afraid
- 4. The Lord is with us
- The stark contrast in vision
 - 1. We can't vs. we can
 - 2. We are weaker vs. they are bread for us
 - 3. We look small vs. their protection is gone
 - 4. No mention of God vs. the Lord is with us and will help us
- Insight into the bigger, better vision of Caleb and Joshua (Joshua 14:7-8 NKJ)
 - 1. Brought word as it was in his heart
 - 2. Wholly followed God
