GUIDED BY GOD Part 8: Ways God Guides and Doesn't Guide

Text: (*Proverbs 3:5-6 NKJV*) *5* Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; 6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.

GUIDED BY GOD'S WORD

- · Where God's word was the final word in a big decision
 - 1. What to do with the Gentiles coming to Christ was a big problem
 - 2. There was a big dispute until James settled things (Acts 15:13-16 NKJV)

GUIDED BY THE WITNESS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

- Paul's example in (Acts 27:9-10 NKJV)
 - 1. Had a perception not a voice
 - 2. He didn't even say the Lord told me
- The Holy Spirit often guides us with His peace (Colossians 3:15 NKJV)
 - 1. He does not shout up to us to pay attention to our heart

GUIDED BY COUNSEL

- Counsel from godly sources (Proverbs 15:22 NKJV)
 - 1. The number one source of counsel is God's word
 - 2. Counsel from others is especially helpful as you are new in your walk with the Lord
 - 3. Beware ungodly counsel

NOT GUIDED BY SIGNS AND CIRCUMSTANCES

- The famous fleece (Judges 6:36-37 NKJV)
 - 1. Gideon asked for a sign to confirm what God had already said to him
 - 2. People often ask for a sign or attribute circumstances to determine God's will
 - 3. Nowhere in the New Testament are we instructed or encouraged to ask for signs
- Favorable situations are not always the Lord's leading (Acts 27:12-13 NKJV)
 - 1. When the south wind blew softly
- Negative circumstances are not always the Lord trying to tell us something (Acts 28:3-6 NKJ)
 - 1. Paul got snake bit and natives said he was a murderer
 - 2. Shook it off unharmed and they thought he was a god
 - 3. The negatives had nothing to do with God's leading and guiding
