LEAN NOT ON YOUR OWN UNDERSTANDING (Proverbs 3:5-6 NKJ)

- · What this is not saying
 - 1. Never use your mind
 - 2. Man's understanding worthless
- Our understanding is founded on different factors
 - 1. Reasonings and logic Nothing wrong with this, but it's still not perfect
 - 2. Observations read/heard/experienced Not everything you read/hear is true
 - 3. Feelings rational and irrational/emotions Can be highly unreliable
 - 4. Traditions things we have often caught from others because it has been passed down does not make it right

IN ALL YOUR WAYS ACKNOWLEDGE HIM

- A key to God's Direction (1 Samuel 23:1-4 NKJ)
 - 1. David asked God before he made a move
 - 2. Was willing to ask again
- The enemy of assumption (1 Samuel 23:10-13 NKJ)
 - 1. David could have assumed that Keilah would back him
 - 2. He acknowledged the Lord and asked

DO NOT BE WISE IN YOUR OWN EYES (Proverbs 3:7-8 NKJ)

- Biblical humility not a low opinion of yourself, but a higher opinion of God and His wisdom
 - 1. I am not all that smart
 - 2. I submit to God and His ways (1 Peter 5:5-6 NKJ)
- Solomon's example
 - Could have been an arrogant man
 - 2. He recognized his need for help (1 Kings 3:7-9 NKJ)
 - 3. His request pleased God (1 Kings 3:10-13 NKJ) (Proverbs 3:13 &16 NKJ)
