THE RESPONSES TO PILATE'S QUESTION WERE VARIED

- To Pilate Jesus was a pressure point
 - 1. He knew there was something different about Jesus
 - 2. Jesus' claim of being the Son of God rattled Pilate
- · To the soldiers Jesus was just another person
 - 1. No regard for who He was or what He represented -
 - 2. They crucified Him
- To the Religious leaders and elite Jesus was a problem
 - 1. Jesus challenged their thinking, belief systems and power structure
 - They opposed Him and wanted Him eliminated
- To many of His followers Jesus was the promise of a better life
 - 1. They believed Jesus would restore Israel to prominence
 - 2. His arrest and crucifixion turned some against Him while others lost hope
- To one of the thieves crucified with Him, He was a personal Saviour Luke 23:39-43 (NKJV)
 - 1. He had the faith to respect God and the humility to acknowledge his own quilt
 - 2. He acknowledged Jesus' perfection and confessed Him as Lord
 - 3. Was rewarded with a promise of a better place with Jesus

THE QUESTION STILL STANDS AND THE RESPONSES ARE STILL VARIED

- To some Jesus is just another person historical, moral teacher etc.
 - 1. And they have no regard for Him; ignore Him
- To many of the intellectual and cultural elite Jesus is a problem
 - 1. He challenges their thinking and beliefs, and power
 - They oppose Him and what He stands for
- To many Jesus is a pressure point They know in their heart He is more than a man
 - 1. Conflicted and pressured by the crowd many take a pass
- To billions around the world He is a personal Saviour
 - 1. Those that acknowledge the reality of God
 - 2. These are the ones who rest in the promise of a better life **John 10:10 (NKJV)**
