## WHAT'S IN A WORD?

- · Common thoughts about words
  - 1. Primarily used to express thoughts and feelings
  - 2. Are often negative
  - 3. Spoken words are often overlooked (just words)
- Called to speak differently (Romans 12:2 NKJ)
  - 1. There is a current of conformity in the world
  - 2. Living differently will involve speaking differently against the current
  - 3. A biblical belief is that our words have value

## A Man Who Spoke Differently

- Different than the doubt and unbelief (1 Samuel 17:26-29 NKJ)
  - 1. David's confident words caused conviction
  - 2. David answered with wisdom
- Different than the negativity and limited thinking (1 Samuel 17:32-37 NKJ)
  - 1. Saul told David he could not fight and could not win stats were against him
  - 2. David repeated what the Lord had done and that the Lord would help him again
- Different than the fear (1 Samuel 17:43-46 NKJ)
  - 1. Goliath was trying to intimidate David
  - 2. David responded back with equal force

## SPEAKING DIFFERENTLY THIS YEAR

- Recognize but don't be stopped by the currents in the world
  - 1. The current of doubt and unbelief
  - 2. The current of limitations and negativity
  - 3. The current of fear (2 Timothy 1:7 NKJ)
- Use God's word as a template
  - 1. A basis for your words not always quoting scripture
  - 2. Use your words to redirect your thoughts (Proverbs 3:5 NKJ)
- Treat words as valuable powerful seeds (Proverbs 18:21 NKJ)
  - 1. Don't plant the wrong seeds
  - 2. Plant what you desire, not what you see
