LESSONS FROM THE ROAD

JESUS' ENCOUNTER WITH HIS FOLLOWERS

- A. Why are you sad? (Luke 24:19-24 NKJV)
 - 1. They lost someone they valued
 - 2. They had unmet expectations they were hoping
 - 3. They did not see Him even though some had reported that He was alive
- B. Jesus redirects their focus (Luke 24:25-27 NKJV)
 - 1. He did not point them to the physical reality
 - He called their attention to the Scriptures
 - 3. He emphasized believing what the Scriptures said
- C. Jesus was invited to stay (Luke 24:28-32 NKJV)
 - 1. He would have kept going
 - 2. Their eyes were opened in the further interaction
 - 3. Their hearts were telling them all along

OUR LESSONS FROM THE ROAD

- A. Start with the Scriptures
 - 1. They become the lens through which we view life
 - 2. The Scriptures become our foundation. (2 Timothy 3:16-27 NLT)
- B. Move beyond the sadness
 - 1. Sadness is often a result of ... (Proverbs 12:25 KJV)
 - 2. Redirect our focus (Proverbs 15:30 NKJV)
 - 3. Recalibrate our words (Proverbs 15:23 NKJV)
- C. God works in our lives by invitation, not force (Revelations 3:20 NKJV)
 - 1. He knocks; we are the ones who open
 - The closer we become to Him, the more we see
