HEART CONDITIONS THAT OPEN THE DOOR TO MORE OF GOD IN OUR LIVES

- A. A heart to know
 - 1. Jesus spoke of ears to hear a hunger, a desire to know
- B. A receptive heart (Mark 4:14-15 NKJ)
 - 1. Wayside Greek word indicates a road or street
 - 2. The word was not received into the ground
 - 3. What is not received is easily stolen
- C. Humility and receptivity are connected (James 1:21-22 NKJ)
 - 1. Meekness is not weakness
 - 2. Humility and meekness are in the same family (James 4:6 NKJ)
 - 3. We are responsible for our humility it's a heart thing (James 4:10 NKJ)
- D. A committed heart (Mark 4:16-17 NKJ)
 - 1. They began with receptivity (Romans 15:13 NKJ)
 - 2. They only stay with their belief for a season
 - 3. Trouble (John 16:33 NKJ)
 - 4. Persecution for the word's sake (1 Peter 3:13-17 NKJ)
- E. Endurance and committed are connected
 - 1. Endurance listed as a productive heart condition (Luke 8:15 NKJ)
 - 2. We need endurance because we live in an environment of resistance
 - 3. Endurance allows us to hold onto our beliefs, our faith (Hebrews 10:35-36 NKJ)
