TEXT: Proverbs 3:5-6 NKJV

DAVID'S EXAMPLE (1 Samuel 23:1-5 NKJV)

- David asked God for wisdom
 - 1. Even though he had a winning record with Philistines
 - 2. Even though there was a great need
- He got pushback from his team
 - 1. They were concerned about themselves
 - 2. They were afraid
- David asked again for confirmation good when others are involved
 - 1. Was assured of God's help went and won

LEARNING FROM DAVID

- · Ask don't assume
 - 1. Based on needs or experience
 - 2. Facts / reasonings / data
 - 3. Ego and selfish motives
- · When facing opposition from others
 - 1. Consider the source (Psalm 1:1 NKJV) (Philippians 2:20-21 NKJV)
 - 2. It's okay to ask God again
- Asking God for wisdom / guidance (James 1:5-8 NKJV)
 - 1. Believe God has the wisdom
 - 2. Believe He will give us that wisdom
 - 3. Ask in faith (Mark 11:24 NKJV)

DAVID'S OTHER PRAYER (1 Samuel 23:10-13 NKJV)

- Will Saul come?
 - 1. Not stop Saul from coming
- Will the men of Keilah give me up?
 - 1. David did not assume they would protect him
 - 2. David did not pray make them protect me

PRAYING FOR PEOPLE

- Not Lord make them...
 - 1. People have choices
 - 2. Pray for enlightenment (Colossians 1:9-11 NKJV) (Acts 26:17-18 NKJV)
