UPGRADING YOUR VISION Part 5: Handling Problems

HOW CAN WE GROW IN OUR VISION OF GOD?

- Start with what is revealed in God's Word
- Take time to meditate on God's Word
- Praise God for His greatness (Psalm 145:3 NKJV)
 - 1. His greatness deserves our praise
 - 2. His greatness extends beyond our mental capacity
- Talk about God being powerful
 - 1. There is a heart-mouth connection (Romans 10:8 NKJV)
 - 2. Start prayer with the bigness of God (Acts 4:24 NKJV)
 - 3. Talk about His greatness and power (Psalm 145:6 &11 NKJV)

OUR PERSPECTIVE AND HANDLING PROBLEMS

- Gideon lived in an oppressive environment (Judges 6:1-2 & 6 NKJV)
 - 1. Israel was hiding from their enemy as opposed to resisting
 - 2. Did not believe they could win
 - 3. Experienced loss for a long time
 - 4. Finally cried out to the Lord
- · Living in a negative situation will have an impact
 - 1. Can cause us to hide from the problems
 - 2. Can cause a loss of expectancy
 - 3. We can also cry out to the Lord (Psalm 86:3-5&7 NKJV)
- God sends an answer to Israel (Judges 6:7-10 NKJV)
 - 1. Israel wanted relief from Midian
 - 2. God sent a prophet with a course correction
 - 3. Part of the answer was to stop worshipping the foreign gods
- God sends answers our way (Proverbs 15:31-32 NKJV)
 - 1. Rebuke is correcting a wrong
 - 2. God's correction leads to life
 - 3. Correction comes through His word, His Holy Spirit, and other people
 - 4. One of the best places to make a correction (Proverbs 15:33 NKJV)
