A BIBLICAL EXAMPLE OF FAITH (Mark 2:1-5; 9-12 NKJV)

- · Recorded for a reason
 - 1. These stories instruct us and encourage us
 - 2. These five men were not named
- Two beliefs these five embraced
 - 1. That Jesus could heal their friend
 - 2. That Jesus was good
- Two beliefs vital to us today (Hebrews 11:6 NKJV)
 - 1. That God is real He exists
 - 2. That God is good He is a rewarder (Psalm 27:13 NKJV)

CHARACTERISTICS OF OUR FAITH

- · Faith is visible
 - 1. Jesus saw their faith (Mark 2:6-8 NKJV)
 - 2. Faith is revealed in actions (James 3:18 NKJV)
- Faith helps us push past challenges that crop up
 - 1. The five could have seen the crowd and turned around discouragement
 - 2. They could have gotten angry at the people offense
 - 3. Busting through the roof was not as easy as it sounds
 - 4. The challenges of life are going to be there (1 Thessalonians 3:2-3 NKJV)
- · Faith helps us overcome fears of this life
 - 1. The leaders of the nations were sitting in the house
 - 2. What would all the people trying to see Jesus think social rejection fear
 - 3. What would Jesus think?
 - 4. As our faith in God grows our fear of men diminishes (Isaiah 51:12-13 NKJV)
