THE LORD'S HELP Part 3

TEXT: Hebrews 13:5-6 NKJV

ACCEPT HELP

- Another position that requires humility
 - 1. God does not use who we choose
 - 2. God does not always do things the way we want it done
- Accept The Helper (John 14:25-26 NKJV)
 - 1. Embrace the Holy Spirit as God's gift to us

A PICTURE OF RECEIVING HELP

- Jabesh Gilead acknowledges their need for help (1 Samuel 11:1-3 NKJV)
 - 1. Facing a situation they could not overcome on their own
 - 2. A deadline was facing them added to the pressure
 - This problem would impact entire families
- Sent to all of Israel asking for help
 - 1. Saul was the only one who responded (1 Samuel 11:5-7 NKJV)
 - 2. The Spirit of God came on Saul
- The people of Jabesh Gilead accepted the help (1 Samuel 11:9-14 NKJV)
 - 1. Accepted the promise of help first
 - 2. Jabesh was glad before the help showed up
 - They attributed the victory to God
- · The rest of this story 40 years later
 - 1. Saul and his sons died on one day in battle
 - 2. The men of Jabesh Gilead did not forget what Saul had done for them (1 Samuel 31:11-13 NKJV)

THE FIVE - A PROCESS

- Acknowledge our need for God's help
 - 1. In matters big and small
- Ask for help from the Lord in line with His word
 - 1. Do not beg or whine
- · Accept His help
 - 1. Embrace the Helper
 - 2. Be glad before seeing the help (1 Peter 1:8 NKJV)
- Attribute the help to the Lord (Psalms 34:2 NKJV)
 - 1. Give Him the credit and brag on Him
- Adulate the Lord
 - 1. Exaggerated praise
 - 2. Praising God and thanking Him is always appropriate (Psalm 96:4 NKJV)
