## WHERE'S THE HEART?

- Common usages
  - 1. To designate desire
  - 2. To designate compassion and love
  - 3. To designate courage
- More than a metaphor (Proverbs 4:23 NKJV)
  - 1. Core of our being
  - 2. Life flows out of our heart
  - 3. Put a guard on mind, mouth and methods

## WHEN HEART MATTERED MOST (Luke 19:1-10 NKJV)

- Zacchaeus had a genuine heart hunger
  - 1. He was powerful and rich
  - 2. His actions revealed his heart
- Jesus responded to a hungry heart
  - 1. Jesus not caught up in societal pressure
  - 2. Religion had rejected Zacchaeus, but Jesus accepted him
- When Zacchaeus realized Jesus had a heart for him
  - 1. Changed him from greedy to giving
  - 2. He went from ripping people off to restoring over and above
  - 3. Jesus used Zacchaeus' example to reiterate His purpose

## **OUR HEART MATTERS**

- God is a heart first God (1 Samuel 16:6-7 NKJV)
  - 1. People are easily moved by appearances
  - 2. God is not moved by a pretty face
- We constantly have to recalibrate our hearts (2 Corinthians 9:7 NKJV)
  - 1. In whatever we do, do it...
  - 2. Do it because we want to
  - 3. Purpose in our hearts is a heart decision
- Jesus love for us is still the best motivator (2 Corinthians 5:15 NKJV)
  - 1. Much easier to make changes when we believe His love for us
  - 2. Love is the best motive for heart change not fear or force
