HOW THE LORD GUIDES HIS PEOPLE - 1ST WAY

- Through His word (2 Timothy 3:16-17 NKJV)
 - 1. His word is the foundation for all direction
- · Where God's word is clear we don't have to pray about guidance
 - 1. Should I serve God? (1 Corinthians 15:58 NKJV)
 - 2. Should I love my brother/sister in Christ? (John 15:12 NKJV)
 - 3. What about sleeping with my boyfriend/girlfriend? (Ephesians 5:2-3 NKJV)
 - 4. Should I give to God's work? (2 Corinthians 9:7 NKJV)
 - 5. Should I go to church? (Hebrews 10:24-25 NKJV)
- · Where God's word was the final word in a big decision
 - 1. What to do with the Gentiles coming to Christ was a big problem
 - 2. There was a big dispute until James settled things (Acts 15:13-20 NKJV)

HOW THE LORD GUIDES HIS PEOPLE - 2ND WAY

- Through the witness of the Spirit (Romans 8:14-16 NKJV)
 - 1. He witnesses to our spirit that we are children of God
 - 2. The witness is more of a perception
 - 3. Paul's example in (Acts 27:9-10 NKJV)
- The witness of the Holy Spirit often comes as peace (Colossians 3:15 NKJV)
 - 1. His peace acts as umpire
 - 2. When we think about moving in a direction or making a decision
- Counsel from godly sources (Proverbs 15:22 NKJV)
 - 1. The number one source of counsel is God's word
 - 2. Counsel from others is especially helpful as you are new in your walk with the Lord
 - 3. Beware ungodly counsel
