A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S JAMES Part 3

WITH NO DOUBTING (James 1:6-8 NKJV)

- The enemy of doubt
 - 1. Do not call yourself a doubter
 - 2. Doubt means to hesitate, to waver, be of two opinions
- Peter's example of doubt (Matthew 14:26-32 NKJV)
 - 1. Peter stepped out on Jesus' word to come
 - 2. He did walk on the water spiritual things are real
 - 3. He started looking at the situation caused fear and sinking
 - 4. Called out to Jesus and was helped
 - 5. Jesus asked him why he doubted

GOD'S KINGDOM OPERATES DIFFERENTLY (James 1:9-11 NKJV)

- Being rich is not a Kingdom advantage
 - 1. The poor are elevated in God's Kingdom, they are not looked down upon
 - 2. The rich are lowered not exalted in God's Kingdom (1 Timothy 6:17 NKJV)

DEALING WITH TEMPTATION (James 1:12-15 NKJV)

- Passing the test
 - 1. Blessed when we persevere in tests and trials
 - 2. Blessed because we receive the crown of life
 - 3. Love for the Lord is a motivator to not giving in
- Do not say this was from the Lord
 - 1. He does not tempt or bring evil into our lives
 - 2. Our own desires are the source of temptation (1 John 2:15-16 NKJV)
 - 3. Lusts, strong desires not acted upon no conception

THE GOD OF GOOD (James 1:16-18 NKJV)

- · Don't be deceived
 - 1. God is good and gives what is good
 - 2. We are born of Him (1 Peter 1:23-24 NKJV)
- And because we are a prime example of His creation (James 1:19-20 NKJV)
 - 1. We excel relationally
 - 2. Implementing the first two things helps with the third objective slow to wrath (*Proverbs 16:32 NKJV*)
 - 3. Our wrath does not display the rightness of God (*Titus 3:1-3 NKJV*)
