## DAVID'S EXAMPLE OF REJOICING

- A. Nowhere to run and hide (1 Samuel 21:10-15 NKJV)
  - 1. Had to run to the enemy's land and then act crazy to escape
  - 2. David wrote the 34th Psalm after this incident
- B. Escaped to a cave (1 Samuel 22:1-2 NKJV)
  - 1. Still concerned for his life
  - 2. All the unhappy people joined him
  - 3. Instead of writing the blues he writes (Psalm 57:1&7 NKJV)

## **BENEFITS OF REJOICING**

- A. Connects us to the Lord and His work in our lives (1 Peter 1:8 NKJV)
  - 1. We can rejoice in the Lord that we have not seen
  - 2. We can rejoice in things we believe but have not seen as yet
- B. Helps us keep from becoming down and despondent (Habakkuk 3:17-19 NKJV)
  - 1. When things are not going to plan we have a choice
  - 2. The writer expressed confidence that God would cause him to walk above the problems
- C. A place of spiritual safety (Philippians 3:1 NKJV)
  - 1. Paul was basically saying "don't get tired of hearing this" (Philippians 4:4 NKJV)
- D. A place of spiritual strength (Nehemiah 8:10 NKJV)
  - 1. We were made for joy not sorrow (Proverbs 15:13 NKJV)
  - 2. We are the ones who determine if we have a merry heart or a sorrowful one
  - 3. Our words will play a major role (Proverbs 15:23 NKJV)
