- People have always had a fascination with the future
 - 1. Nostradamus 16th Century French astrologer, doctor and supposed seer
 - 2. Futurist studies the future and makes predictions based on current trends
 - 3. The age old lineup of psychics, fortune tellers, mediums
 - 4. Even the disciples asked Jesus about the future He spoke of wars, earthquakes, pestilence
- · We won't know everything the future holds but we can handle it
 - 1. We have His promises
 - 2. We have His peace
 - 3. We have The Helper (John 16:13 NKJV)

A MAN FACING A CHALLENGING FUTURE

- Into uncertainty
 - 1. Jacob was isolated from his family due to a major conflict
 - 2. Forced him to journey into relatively unknown territory
- Jacob faced the future armed with the blessing (Genesis 28:10-16 NKJV)
 - 1. He had been given the blessings of the covenant agreement with God
 - 2. At his current state he did not look like the blessed alone and sleeping on a rock
- · God shows up in his life
 - 1. Revealed Himself to Jacob in a dream
 - 2. God promised him help, safety and a future
 - 3. Jacob acknowledged God was present and he was not aware
- Jacob's response (Genesis 28:20-22 NKJV)
 - 1. God became His God not just his heritage
 - 2. He committed to giving God a tenth didn't have to, wanted to

AS WE FACE THE ROAD AHEAD

- This will be a walk of faith
 - 1. We are the walking blessed
 - 2. We are not alone (Hebrews 13:5b-6 NKJV)
- We are people of promise
 - 1. God's promises are because of our connection to Jesus (2 Corinthians 1:20 NKJV)
 - 2. God's promises speak to our past, present and future
- The reality of God enables us to face the future without fear
 - 1. More than just our parents or grandparents God He is our God
 - 2. More than just a Sunday God He has a bigger role in our life
 - 3. More than just a God we acknowledge He acknowledges us and keeps us (2 Timothy 1:12 NKJV)
