PURPOSE OF LEARNING ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT

A. For growth in the following three areas . . .

- 1. Recognition of the Holy Spirit and His role
- 2. Respect/reverence of the Holy Spirit in our personal lives
- 3. Responding to the Holy Spirit's help in our lives

THE HOLY SPIRIT WAS SPOKEN ABOUT BY THE OLD TESTAMENT PROPHETS

A. Isaiah described His characteristics (Isaiah 11:2 NKJV)

- 1. Those attributes have not changed
- B. Ezekiel spoke of a coming day, which is now the time frame we are living *(Ezekiel 36:26-27 NKJV)*
 - 1. The heart of flesh is the new creation
 - 2. The Spirit within takes place at the New Birth

C. Joel spoke of the coming day and the Holy Spirit's outpouring *(Joel 2:28-29 NKJV)*

- 1. The passage Peter spoke of on the day of Pentecost
- 2. A distinction is made here of the Holy Spirit within and the Holy Spirit upon

THE HOLY SPIRIT'S HELP FOR THE NATION OF ISRAEL (Exodus 13:21-22 NKJV)

A. The Lord went before them in the presence of a cloud/fire

- 1. The Holy Spirit manifesting as fire was evident on the day of Pentecost
- 2. The Holy Spirit manifesting as a cloud at the dedication of the temple
- 3. The Lord led His people through the wilderness (Numbers 9:15-17 NKJV)

B. We have a better covenant than the nation of Israel had

- 1. Now we are the temple of God (1 Corinthians 3:16 NKJV)
- 2. And the Holy Spirit can lead us also inward, not outward

THE HOLY SPIRIT IN THE LIFE OF JESUS

A. Pre and post birth

- 1. The Holy Spirit at conception (Luke 1:34-38 NKJV)
- 2. The Holy Spirit encouraged Mary during her pregnancy (Luke 1:39-43 NKJV)
- 3. The Holy Spirit confirmed Jesus at His dedication (Luke 2:25-30 NKJV)
