TEXT: 2 Corinthians 13:14 NKJ

JESUS SPEAKS ABOUT THE ONE HE KNOWS WELL

- The Holy Spirit came and descended on Jesus (John 1:32-34 NKJ)
 - 1. The Spirit descended on Jesus and remained on Him
 - John contrasted baptizing in water and baptizing in the Holy Spirit
- The Spirit of Truth (John 14:15-18 NKJ)
 - 1. A huge help knowing truth (John 8:32 NKJ)
 - 2. The world can not receive Him
 - 3. With and in
- The Helper would come in Jesus' name (John 14:25-26 NKJ)
 - 1. To represent and act in the authority of Jesus
 - 2. The disciples operated in Jesus' name (Acts 5:40-41 NKJ)
- Part of His help is teaching and reminding
 - Jesus had been their teacher
 - 2. He can teach all things because He knows all things (2 Corinthians 2:12-13 NKJ)
 - 3. The Holy Spirit reminds us

JESUS CALLS THE HOLY SPIRIT OUR ADVANTAGE (John 16:5-7 NKJ)

- Jesus had done so much for them, and they were sad
 - 1. Jesus had answers for all their questions and problems He always knew what to do
 - He filled their days with an expectation of something amazing He always knew where to go
 - 3. He was fearless in the face of trouble and made them fearless He was always calm
 - 4. He gave them a sense of divine destiny and purpose
- The Holy Spirit is our advantage because He is always with us
 - 1. He always knows what to do (Because He knows all things)
 - 2. He always knows which way to go (Romans 8:14 NKJ)
 - 3. He is always calm (2 Timothy 1:7 NKJ)
 - 4. He gives us a sense of divine destiny and purpose (Romans 8:15-16 NKJ)
