## WAKING UP IN A NEW WORLD

- A. The culture shifted
  - 1. Pandemic and revealed division in our nation
  - 2. Racial / social tension
  - 3. Disruption of order
  - 4. The apparent demise of freedom of speech
- B. The scriptures foretold of these days (2 Timothy 3:1,13-14 NLT)
  - 1. A list of how people would act; scoffing at God, slander others, cruel, hate what is good
  - 2. But God has a plan for us to thrive we'll have to remain faithful to what we know is true

## DANIEL WAKING UP IN BABYLON

- A. Daniel may have been shocked but he was not overwhelmed (Daniel 1:3-5 NKJV)
  - 1. The most modern, powerful culture on the earth
  - 2. Vastly different from the God honoring culture of Israel
  - 3. Had to be immense pressure to stay in the leadership academy
- B. They changed Daniel's name but not his heart for God (Daniel 1:6-8 NKJV)
  - 1. Changed from God honoring names to names that reflected Babylonian gods
  - 2. But Daniel purposed in his heart eating the king's food went against God's laws
  - 3. Handled his differences with dignity did not rail against or condemn the culture
- C. God moved on Daniel's behalf (Daniel 1:17,19-20 NKJV)
  - 1. They honored God and He honored them
  - 2. God caused Daniel and friends to excel despite the environment beyond the culture shapers

## SUCCESSFULLY NAVIGATING TIMES LIKE THESE

- A. Be aware of the environment we are in but...
  - Not awestruck time to stop acting so shocked
  - 2. Not afraid overly concerned with the backlash from the cancel culture
  - 3. Not ashamed the gospel is still the power of God to salvation
- B. Purpose in our hearts to stay connected to God and His ways
  - 1. Purpose; to commit, determine to stay connected to our identity in Christ
  - 2. We can live in this culture without the culture living in us
  - 3. There are still things that stain us spiritually (2 Peter 2:8 NLT)
- C. By God's grace we can excel in this current environment
  - 1. We act with dignity toward others regardless
  - 2. We honor God by walking in His ways (Psalm 1:1-3 NKJV)
