#### Text: Psalm 118:15

## **LEARNING A NEW VOICE**

- A. Writing to people with no religious background (Ephesians 4:17 NKJV)
  - 1. Don't walk or live as the rest of the Gentiles
  - 2. Paul had spent the first 3 chapters of this letter talking about what Jesus had done for them
- B. The process of putting off the old, putting on the new (Ephesians 4:21-24 NKJV)
  - 1. Putting away the former conduct
  - 2. Putting off the old because that is no longer who we are
- C. The catalyst is to renew our minds
  - 1. Not just new information but new information that we practice
- D. One key area of mind renewal is Feelings vs. Action driven
  - 1. An important part of putting off the old man to put on the new
  - 2. We are not what we feel, we are what we do
  - 3. We have been trained to believe we are hypocrites if we act differently than our feelings
- E. Putting on the new man that was created (key word)
  - 1. Created right with God and separated for Him
  - 2. Paul said nothing about feelings, he talked about putting on action

# HOW DO THE RIGHTEOUS ACT AND TALK? (Ephesians 4:25-32 NKJV)

### A. Actions

- 1. Angry without sinning
- 2. Stop stealing work to give
- 3. No stinky attitudes
- 4. Be kind, tender hearted and forgiving
- 1. No lying; we speak truth (Ephesians 4:15 NKJV)
- 2. No toxic poison words that cause harm and hurt
- 3. No clamor loud quarreling (James 3:17 NKJV)
- 4. Evil speaking verbal abuse against someone
