GOD SEES DIFFERENTLY (1 Samuel 16:6-7 NKJ)

- Two perspectives
 - 1. Man looks at outward appearance
 - 2. God looks at the heart

THE CENTURION; A MAN WITH GREAT HEART (Luke 7:1-10 NKJ)

- · A heart of love for people
 - 1. His servant was dear to him
 - 2. His actions had convinced the Jewish leaders of his love for Israel
- A heart of humility
 - 1. Even though the centurion had greater social and legal power
 - 2. His words calling Jesus Lord
- · A heart of faith
 - 1. All he needed was for Jesus to give the word
 - 2. He did not need for Jesus to come to the servant
 - 3. Jesus was astonished at the centurion's faith

DEVELOPING A GREAT HEART

- A heart of love (Ephesians 5:1-2 NLT)
 - 1. We are called to live this way
 - 2. We may never have to give our physical lives
 - 3. Redefine how we look at love
- · A heart of humility
 - 1. Acknowledge God as greater
 - 2. The language of pride is I've got this; it's my way
 - 3. The humble heart gets the grace (1 Peter 5:5-6 NKJ)
- A heart of faith (2 Corinthians 5:7 NKJ)
 - 1. This is how we live this life
 - 2. We tune into God's Word faith comes by hearing
