WHAT DOES LIVING BIGGER LOOK LIKE?

- Common thoughts
 - 1. More resources
 - 2. Less fear fear is restricting
 - 3. Bigger goals/purpose
- With God there is a bigger way of living (Romans 12:2 NKJV)
 - 1. The focus shifts from your kingdom to God's kingdom
 - 2. Instead of what's best for me what honors God and helps people

WHEN PETER'S WORLD BECAME BIGGER (Luke 5:3-11 NKJV)

- He said yes to Jesus
 - 1. When Jesus asked to use his boat no demands, not begging or apologizing
 - 2. Peter could have said no
 - 3. He was given an opportunity to be a part of something bigger
- · Peter was blessed for his service
 - 1. Not the reason he let Jesus use his boat
 - 2. Peter had to trust that Jesus had his best interests in mind
- Peter connected with God's bigger purpose for his life
 - 1. The massive catch was a temporary blessing
 - 2. God's bigger purpose for him involved people eternal

TRANSFORMATIONAL THINKING REGARDING LEARNING TO LIVE BIGGER

- Say yes to Jesus to the privilege of partnership (1 Corinthians 15:58 NKJV)
 - 1. There is a work of the Lord
 - 2. It is not a wasted investment of time, effort and resources
- There are still blessings associated with serving God's Kingdom
 - 1. He does not forget what we do for Him (Hebrews 6:10 NKJV)
 - 2. We have to believe He has our best interests in mind
- There is more than just blessings
 - 1. So much of what we strive for is so temporary
 - 2. What we do for God has eternal value living beyond the blessings
