It's Not Just What We Go Through But How We Go Through

A. This isn't heaven yet

- 1. Evil is here
- 2. People do crazy wrong things
- 3. This world's system operates in the dark (fear, selfishness, negativity)

B. But Jesus let us know this ahead of time (John 16:33 NIV)

- 1. This is why staying connected to Him is important
- 2. He is the One who helps us overcome

JOSEPH: KEEPING A LIGHT ON IN THE DARK

A. Made the most in a bad situation (Genesis 39:3-5 NIV)

- 1. Joseph must have done good work
- 2. He must have kept a good attitude
- 3. Joseph gave God something to bless and blessed the Egyptian because of him

B. From bad to worse (Genesis 39:7-10 NIV)

- 1. Joseph was honorable even as a slave
- 2. Even though Joseph was doing the right thing (Genesis 39:17-23 NIV)

C. But the Lord was with him

- 1. Joseph had to have held on to the dream, his promise from God
- 2. God's favor plus Joseph's good attitude caused him to prosper even in a prison

WHAT IF JOSEPH WAS OUR MENTOR: WHAT COULD HE TELL US?

A. Stay connected to God's blessings (Deuteronomy 28:2 & 8 NIV)

- 1. Blessings from obedience and from action
- 2. We actually have a better connection with God through the Lord Jesus

B. Bitter won't make better

- 1. We can't control what people do we can control our response
- 2. Bitterness does not lead to a good place toward people or toward God
- 3. Reject the temptation to be derailed by bitterness we chose what we hold onto

C. Keep a "But God" perspective

1. Whatever we are dealing with is not the last word (Romans 8:31 NIV)
