THE POWER OF COMMITMENT

COMMITMENT

- · Defined: A trait of sincere steadfast fixity of purpose
 - 1. The act of binding yourself to a course of action
- Commitment speaks to something in us
 - 1. We are moved/inspired by stories of commitment
- God's kingdom operates on commitment (Psalm 15:1-4 NLT)
 - 1. These are all character traits that please God

A PICTURE OF COMMITMENT (2 Samuel 21:8-14 NLT)

- · Nothing of note about Rizpah
 - 1. A concubine of Saul not enough status to marry
- What does stand out is her commitment to her sons
 - 1. Loved her boys couldn't stand to see their bodies desecrated
 - 2. Her commitment was not comfortable
- · Rizpah's commitment spoke to David
 - 1. Moved him to do the right thing for Saul/Jonathan
 - 2. Her commitment blessed the other mother of the five sons

How Do We Level Up Our Commitment To The Lord

- A bigger purpose leads to a stronger commitment
 - 1. Rizpah's love for her sons and her desire to see them treated right
 - For us living to love and honor the Lord is our highest purpose (2 Corinthians 5:14-15 NLT)
 - 3. Making the shift from what I can get from the Lord
 - 4. This enables us to push past things that are not comfortable/convenient
- Recognize, acknowledge, and believe the Lord's commitment to us
 - 1. The cross was a hard price to pay (Mark 14:32-36 NLT)
 - 2. The Lord's commitment to us is the foundation of our commitment to Him (Isaiah 50:7 NLT)
