- Three things the Christmas season brings
 - 1. Food
 - 2. Lights
 - 3. Reflection
- · A season where God is more openly acknowledged
 - 1. God's gift to mankind
 - 2. The hope we have in Jesus Christ God's Son (Luke 1:79 NKJ)

A COUPLE HAS THEIR HOPE RENEWED (Luke 1:11-20 NKJ)

- Zacharias and Elizabeth had not abandoned God
 - 1. They were living right before God
 - 2. They had abandoned hope in God's promises
- A supernatural experience
 - 1. An angelic visitation a rare occurrence
 - 2. Zacharias would not believe the message
 - 3. The silence was a safety net so Zacharias would not disconnect from God's promise
- · Zacharias missed the big picture
 - 1. The child would cause great joy and gladness but...
 - 2. The purpose was not simply to make a couple happy, but God had a plan

RENEWING HOPE IN YOUR LIFE

- It's possible for you to see God's goodness in your life
 - 1. Don't allow age, time and past experiences to determine the parameters of your future
 - 2. Become more spiritually oriented (Proverbs 3:5 NKJ)
- Talk yourself into God's promises, not out of them
 - 1. It's important to have a scriptural basis for what you believe (2 Peter 1:4 NKJ)
 - 2. Treat God's promises as great and precious
- Tie into God's bigger plan
 - 1. God's promises being fulfilled...
 - 2. God's bigger plan is to make you a light and a blessing to others
