TEXT: Ephesians 6:10 NKJV

OUR NEED FOR SPIRITUAL ARMOR (Ephesians 6:11-13 NKJV)

- Spiritual armor for our spiritual environment
 - 1. Enables us to stand against what Satan throws at us
 - 2. People are not our problem so don't get caught up fighting against people
- Truth (Ephesians 6:14 NKJV)
 - 1. We are living in the days of deception
 - 2. The truth of God's word is protection for us (John 17:17 NKJV)
- The response to God's word is important (Acts 17:10-12 NKJV)
 - 1. Noble open / fair-minded and honoring of God
 - 2. Received the word did not reject the message
 - 3. Double checked the message with the scriptures to determine truth

THE CONTRAST

- The people in Jesus' hometown (Mark 6:1-6 NKJV)
 - 1. Not open and fair-minded skeptical and guestioning
 - 2. They did not receive Jesus with eagerness
 - 3. Offended and rejected the truth no honor
 - 4. This led to unbelief and them missing out on God's blessings
- The people across the lake (Mark 6:53-56 NKJV)
 - 1. Immediately recognized Him
 - 2. Ran throughout the region some excitement
 - 3. Very honoring of Jesus no special treatment
 - 4. Received miraculous results

THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

- Righteousness
 - 1. Right, just
 - 2. Being just and right without any deficiency or failure
- Positional righteousness
 - 1. No one righteous on their own (Romans 3:9-10 NKJV)
 - 2. God's righteousness through faith (Romans 3:21-26 NKJV)
 - 3. Righteousness is one of the pillars of our gospel (Romans 1:16-17 NKJV)
- Practical righteousness
 - 1. Conforming to what is just and right in the sight of God (2 Timothy 2:22 NKJV)
 - 2. Being made righteous means we can live righteous (1 Peter 2:21-24 NKJV)
