GOD ALWAYS OFFERS CHOICES

A. From the Old Testament to The New Testament

- 1. Choose who you will serve and choose life (Deuteronomy 30:19 NKJV)
- 2. Jesus knocks our choice as to whether we open (Revelation 3:20 NKJV)

B. When choices conflict (Numbers 32:5-7 NKJV)

- 1. These two tribes had not seen or walked in the promised land
- Chose to stay where they were and not cross over
- 3. Moses issued a strong warning don't discourage but rather help
- 4. There is a "promised land" for God's people not heaven

JESUS' INSTRUCTIONS TO HIS DISCIPLES

A. Go into all the world but first wait for the Promise (Acts 1:4-5 NKJV)

1. Baptized - to be fully covered, immersed (Luke 3:16 NKJV)

B. The Promise of power (Acts 1:8 NKJV)

1. The closest ones to Jesus encouraged to receive the promise of power

C. The Promise fulfilled (Acts 2:1-4 NKJV)

- 1. The day of Pentecost was a Jewish feast 50 days from Passover
- 2. This time the Holy Spirit filled human temples
- 3. Evidence of power Peter speaking to the gathered crowds (Acts 2:37-38 NKJV)

THE EVENTS ON THE DAY OF PENTECOST NOT A ONE TIME OCCURRENCE

A. Branched out to Samaritans (Acts 8:4-5,12-13 NKJV)

- 1. Jesus was preached to the Samaritans
- 2. People believed and were baptized visible tangible miracles were taking place
- 3. Peter and John sent to pray for the new believers in Samaria (Acts 8:14-19 NKJV)

B. Help for the Gentiles (Acts 10:39-43 NKJV)

- Classic salvation message Jesus came, killed, raised up and offered to those who believe
- 2. God moved outside of their religious box (Acts 10:44-48 NKJV)
