**THE NEVER ENDING QUEST FOR WISDOM**

- Sources of wisdom
  1. YouTube gurus - exercise caution
  2. Quotes and anecdotes
  3. Family members - passing down lessons and values
- The best source of wisdom (***Job 12:13 NLT***)
  1. God's word - His general wisdom
  2. The Holy Spirit - reveals God's specific wisdom

**SOLOMON'S PURSUIT OF WISDOM** (***2 Chronicles 1:6-12 NKJ***)

- Solomon had a heart for God
  1. Loved the Lord - walked in His ways
  2. Sought the Lord and gave a significant offering
- Solomon acknowledged God's goodness and his need for God
  1. He recognized God's goodness in giving David a successor
  2. Solomon acknowledged his need for God - picture of humility
  3. He believed that God was the source of the wisdom he needed
- God was pleased with Solomon's request
  1. He was not asking for personal gain - not selfish
  2. God gave him more than he asked for

**IN GOD I TRUST FOR WISDOM**

- Start with a heart for God (***Matthew 22:37-38 NKJ***)
  1. To love God...
- Add a heart to bless others
  1. Love those in our world - especially those who are part of God's family
  2. A heart to be a blessing (***Matthew 6:33 NKJ***)
- Ask God for His wisdom for your situation (***James 1:5-6 NIV***)
  1. We believe He has the wisdom we need
  2. We trust He will give us the wisdom we need
  3. We ask trusting Him so we are expecting
