## THINGS HAVE CHANGED

- A new creation and there's more (Ephesians 2:19 NKJV)
  - 1. Members of a new family
  - 2. Citizens of a new kingdom

## A MAN WHO GOT IT RIGHT (Mark 5:21-24 NKJV)

- · Jairus treated Jesus as greater
  - 1. He was a man of great status in the Jewish community
  - By falling at Jesus' feet he sent a message
- Jairus believed Jesus was greater than his crisis
  - 1. Your little girl dying at home is crisis level
  - 2. Jairu's request indicated what he believed
- Jairus did not give in to fear (Mark 5:35-43 NKJV)
  - 1. Not when Jesus took time with another person in need
  - 2. Not when things took a turn for the worse
  - 3. He did what Jesus commanded which meant it was important and possible
- Jairus stayed close to Jesus
  - 1. He had opportunities to rush home or pressure Jesus
  - 2. Even when Jesus kicked out the mourners

## TRANSLATING WHAT JAIRUS DID RIGHT INTO OUR NEW LIFE WITH CHRIST

- It is right to treat Jesus as Greater (Philippians 2:9-11 NKJV)
  - 1. Regardless of our status on earth, He is greater
  - 2. Every knee bowing is more than symbolic
- It is right to treat Jesus as greater than what we are facing
  - 1. We see Him as our answer (2 Chronicles 20:12 NKJV)
  - 2. There are times we will not have the ability or know what to do
- It is right to not give in to fear
  - 1. What Jesus said to Jairus is still in play do not be afraid, only believe
  - 2. Only believe implies we have something else to believe instead of the fear
  - 3. A key to not giving into fear is not acting on fear
- It is right to stay close to the Lord (Psalm 73:28 NKJV)
  - 1. He is not running from us
